

2007 McCLOY FELLOWSHIPS IN JOURNALISM

The American Council on Germany is seeking applications from German journalists in relatively early stages of their careers for the McCloy Fellowships in Journalism. German McCloy Fellows are given the opportunity to travel to the United States for up to 28 days to conduct interviews with policymakers and experts, pursue timely articles, and meet with their transatlantic counterparts. Transatlantic roundtrip airfare and approved inter-city travel costs are covered by the program. Fellows also receive a daily stipend of \$150 to cover housing, meals, and local transportation.

Past fellows have investigated issues such as the American health care system, multicultural and multiethnic radio broadcasting in the United States, economic cooperation in the U.S.-Mexico border region, labor and the U.S. automobile industry, and comparative perspectives on a wide range of other public policy issues. Fellows' research often results in newspaper articles or broadcasts, and several fellows have expanded their projects into books.

Journalists attached to media organizations as well as freelance journalists are encouraged to apply. Working knowledge of the English language is a prerequisite for the program.

Applications from German journalists are reviewed in conjunction with Ruhr-Universität Bochum. To apply, please submit: 1) a cover letter outlining your personal and professional objectives for the fellowship; 2) a project proposal of at least two pages detailing the background and scope of your project, the general sources and institutions with whom you would like to consult while in the United States, and the relevance of the project for transatlantic relations; 3) a current curriculum vitae; and 4) two letters of recommendation to:
